



1. Final Task Assignment

The task consists in embroidering a piece of linen to be provided on the day of the competition.

- 1- Contestants must embroider an imposed pattern. A template will be provided on the day of the competition, which contestants will copy on the piece of fabric on the area of their choosing. In order to do so, contestants shall make use of the various types of stitches listed below, as well as of the colors to be specified on the day of the competition.
- 2- Contestants must also embroider a free part inspired by a specific theme to be revealed on the day of the competition. This free part shall serve as a decoration visually enhancing the imposed part.

In order to complete this part, contestants shall use at least 5 different colors of thread and at least 4 different types of stitches among the following: French knot, Lazy daisy, Buttonhole, Feather stitch, Chain stitch, Whipped running stitch, Spider web stitch, Fern stitch and Stem stitch.

2. Allocated time: 6h00

6 hours of competition.

3. Requirements

- Contestants will take the time to inspect the provided materials before the beginning of the contest. If any defect is noticed, contestants will notify the jury in order to have the defective materials replaced. Once the contest has started, no materials will be replaced.
- Contestants must remain in their workstations. They are not allowed to talk between them or to any person of the public. Any contestant caught cheating, talking to

someone from the public or using a communication device will suffer a penalty of 5 points for the first transgression. A second transgression will lead to an exclusion from the contest.

- Contestants will notify the jury when they finish the task.

4. Procedure

J-1 (March 24th): On the day before the competition, contestants will be welcomed by members of the jury on the contest stand. A briefing about the organization of the competition and the safety rules will be arranged. The jury will performed an inspection of each contestant's equipment and a random draw will be organized in order to assign a work station to each contestant.

Day 1 (March 25th): Contestants will have 3 hours and 30 minutes to work on the task.

Day 2 (March 26th): Contestants will have 2 hours and 30 minutes to finish the task.
