

Vocational Skills Contest

V02 Cabinet Making (Advanced Course)

1. Task Assignment

The task consists in making a box and its lid using a plan which will be handed out to contestants on the day of the competition. Contestants will then install hinges and a lock.

The provided elements will already be partly machined.

Contestants will trace the joints and craft them by hand, without the use of a machine tool.

The box shall be assembled using dovetail joints, with its bottom locked into position by grooves.

The lid shall be assembled using mitered mortise and tenon joints.

All the fabrication details will be revealed on the day of the competition.

Types of wood to be used: - Sides, front and back of the box: cherry wood.

- Bottom: 6mm plywood.
- Top: mullions and transoms in sycamore wood.
- Panel: 6mm Plexiglas.

2. Allocated Time: 6H00

6 hours of competition.



3. Requirements

- Contestants must respect the safety rules.
- The use of any electrical tool is forbidden. Only professional hand tools shall be used. All the parts will already be partly machined (wood-bending, grooves, mortises). Contestants will perform the tracing, assemble the parts by hand, carve slots for the hinges and the lock, install and adjust them, and finally perform the sanding.
- Contestants will manage their time in order to complete the box within the allocated time. It is strongly recommended to perform the assembling and the gluing of the parts before the lunch break so that the contestants may then remove the clamps and complete their work.
- If any defects are found, contestants can have the parts replaced before the beginning of the competition. Two (2) points shall be deducted for any replacements requested once the competition has begun. Furthermore, contestants may only request the replacement of 2 parts maximum.
- Contestants are allowed to use a quick-setting glue.
- The jury will inspect the contestants' toolboxes before the competition. Any tool not referenced in chart n°6 (electric drill, sander machine...) which may cause safety concerns or give a clear advantage to its user will be removed.
- Any contestant caught cheating, talking to someone from the public or using a communication device will suffer a penalty of 5 points for the first transgression. A second transgression will lead to an exclusion from the contest.

4. Procedure

Day -1 (March 24th): On the day before the competition, contestants will be welcomed on the stand "V02 Cabinet Making (Advanced Course)" by the members of the jury. A briefing about the organization of the competition and the safety rules will be arranged and the jury will perform an inspection of the contestant's toolboxes. Contestants will draw lots to be assigned to a work station, where they may drop off their tools.

Day 1 (March 25th): Contestants will have 6 hours to complete the task.

Day 2 (March 26th): Contestants will go on an organized trip.
