V04 Crochet Work

1. Task Assignment

The task consists in the completion of 2 modules.

- <u>Module n°1</u>: Contestants will create a mandala using crochet work, following the provided instructions regarding the choice of colors and the stitches.

These instructions as well as a sample of the mandala will be provided on the day of the contest.

The pictures below show some examples of mandalas. Important: Please note that these are not the final task assignment!







The pictures below are examples of mandalas produced using crochet work. Again, please note that these are not the final task assignment!







- <u>Module n°2</u>: Contestants will imagine and to produce a decoration element which will make the mandala convertible into a purse (flat bag convertible into a purse when folded up).

2. Allocated time: 5H30

5 hours and 30 minutes of competition. Contestants will have to manage their time in order to be able to do both tasks.



3. Requirements

- Contestants will take the time to inspect the provided materials before the beginning of the contest. If any defect is noticed, contestants will notify the jury in order to have the defective materials replaced. Once the contest has started, no materials will be replaced.

Contestants must remain in their workstations. They are not allowed to talk among themselves. Any contestant caught cheating, talking to someone from the public or using a communication device will suffer a penalty of 5 points for the first transgression. A second transgression will lead to an exclusion from the contest.
Contestants will notify the jury when they finish the task.

4. (Procedure)

Day -1 (March 24th): On the day before the competition, contestants will be welcomed on the stand "V04 Crochet Work" by the members of the jury. A briefing about the organization of the competition and the safety rules will be arranged. Due to the large number of registered contestants, the competition will be organized in two groups: contestants will be assigned a group and working hours by drawing lots. Contestants from a same delegation will inevitably be placed in the same group. Each contestant will receive a schedule with the detailed working hours.

Day 1 (March 25th): Group 1 will have 5 hours and 30 minutes to complete modules n°1 and 2.

Day 2 (March 26th): Group 2 will have 5 hours and 30 minutes to complete modules n°1 and 2.
