Vocational Skills Contest

V09 Painting

1. Task Assignment

The task consists in the completion of 2 modules.

- **Module n°1:** Contestants will take inspiration from the painting below (Magritte's *The Victory*, 1939) and will paint a given theme which will be specified on the day of the competition.



The composition will include four compulsory elements which will be specified on the day of the contest.

Attention: Please note that the provided painting is only for your inspiration. You don't have to copy or to recreate it! You are free to choose the "opening element" to be represented in your painting.

- **Module n°2:** Contestants will highlight one precise element of the painting executed during module n°1. They will enlarge and enhance this element.

2. Allocated time: 5H30

5 hours and 30 minutes of competition.



3. Requirements

- Module n°1: The painting will be executed on a paper or canvas support (of a given size). Contestants are free to choose their painting technique among the following ones: water painting, oil painting, acrylic painting, watercolors or mixed technique (contestants may use their personal painting palette). Contestants will take care to balance the composition and to respect the main laws of perspective. They will make sure to use a diversified color palette.
- Module n°2: Given size (approximately 40cm x 40cm). The painting will be executed on wood support. Contestants are free to use an oil painting technique or an acrylic painting technique.

4. Procedure

Day -1 (March 24th): On the day before the competition, contestants will be welcomed on the stand “V09 Painting” by the members of the jury. A briefing about the organization of the contest and about the security rules will be arranged. Due to the large number of registered contestants, the contest will be organized in several groups. Contestants from a same delegation will be inevitably placed in the same group. Each contestant will receive a schedule with the detailed working hours. Contestants will draw lots to be assigned to a work station, where they may drop off their tools.

Day 1 (March 25th): Group n°1 will have 5 hours and 30 minutes to complete modules n°1 and 2.

Day 2 (March 26th): Group n°2 will have 5 hours and 30 minutes to complete modules n°1 and 2.
