# Vocational Skills Contest

## V12 Waste Reuse

### 1. Task Assignment

The task consists in creating a display stand using corks as main material (cork caps for wine bottles). Contestants will have to shape and assemble the corks provided but will be also allowed to bring and use other domestic waste materials. The display stand function is to enhance two complementary objects in a shop window. The nature of these two objects will be specified on the day of the contest.

### 2. Allocated time: 6H00

6 hours of competition.

Day 1 (March 25<sup>th</sup>): 3 hours and 30 minutes.

Day 1 (March 26<sup>th</sup>): 2 hours and 30 minutes.



### 3. Requirements

- The corks should represent at least 50% of the volume of the waste materials used in the production of the final object. Contestants are allowed to bring other reusable domestic waste materials (limit of 50% of the final volume of the production) as well as other personal hand tools. These materials cannot be shaped or elaborated before the day of the contest.
- Contestants should use all of the allocated time for the completion of the task.
- Contestants are not allowed to lend or to borrow any tool or material during the contest. Any contestant caught cheating, talking to someone from the public or using a communication device will suffer a penalty of 5 points for the first transgression. A second transgression will lead to an exclusion from the contest.
- Contestants must respect the safety rules.







### 4. (Procedure)









**Day -1 (March 24<sup>th</sup>):** On the day before the competition, contestants will be welcomed on the stand “V12 Waste Reuse” by members of the jury. A briefing about the organization of the contest and about the security rules will be arranged. Contestants will draw lots to be assigned to a work station, where they may drop off their tools.

**Day 1 (March 25<sup>th</sup>):** The final task assignment will be presented to the contestants. They will have approximately 3 hours and 30 minutes of work.

**Day 2 (March 26<sup>th</sup>):** Contestants will have approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes to complete the task.
