Vocational Skills Contest

V49 Tailoring

1. Task Assignment

The task consists in cutting and making a men's jacket with a small straight collar, long sleeves, two patch pockets, one faux welt pocket and a slit in the middle of the back. The fabric provided will be cotton canvas. The elements of the template will be provided along with the specific design on the day of the competition.

2. Allocated time: 6h00

6 hours of competition.



3. Requirements

- Using a complete technical file (sketches of the design and instructions), fabric, a template and all the potential accessories composing the article of clothing, contestants will start with the placement of the template's elements on the material then notify the jury for evaluation. The jury will provide a correction if necessary and contestants will resume their work.

- Contestants are not allowed to lend or borrow any equipment for the duration of the competition. Any contestant caught cheating, talking to someone from the public or using a communication device will suffer a penalty of 5 points for the first transgression. A second transgression will lead to an exclusion from the contest.

4. Procedure

Day -1 (March 24th): On the day before the competition, contestants will be welcomed on the stand "V49 Tailoring" by the members of the jury. A briefing about the organization of the competition and the safety rules will be arranged.

- Due to the large number of registered contestants, the competition will be organized in two groups. Contestants from a same delegation will inevitably be placed in the same group. Each contestant will receive a schedule with the detailed working hours. Contestants will draw lots to be assigned to a work station, where they may drop off their tools.

- For safety and fairness reasons, the jury will perform an inspection of each contestant's personal tools. The jury has the final decision-making power in authorizing or forbidding the use of these tools.

Day 1 (March 25th): Group n°1 will have 6 hours to complete the task. Group n°2 will go on an organized trip.

Day 2 (March 26th): Group n°2 will have 6 hours to complete the task. Group n°1 will go on an organized trip.
